

## Good packing advice



Turn for packing list ->

- 🌸 Mark clothes and equipment with your name. This greatly improves the possibility for getting your own stuff back home again. Nail polish is perfect for writing name or initials on the cutlery. Do *not* make an X or the like because this could be done by others as well and then we still are not any further.
- 🌸 Pack your own stuff. Then you know where it is and what you have brought along. 😊 Your mom and dad may of course help you.
- 🌸 When you pack your backpack the be aware that you shall be able to carry it yourself. The trick is to bring as little as possible, but still enough 😊 You shall be able to carry your stuff for up to 1 kilometer yourself.
- 🌸 Remember that when we are at camp, we do not dress in fresh clothes every day – probably underwear/panties as an exception 😊.
- 🌸 Remember to count the clothes your wear when you make the list on the back side of this sheet.
- 🌸 Pack your stuff in freezer bags and white garbage bags. Then it is much easier for you to see what you have and then it is also watertight. Pack in categories, e.g. underwear in one bag, T-shirt and blouses in another etc. Use a marker pen for writing and/or draw on the bag; this helps when you have to find your stuff.  
Important – when you close the bags then do it with a knot that you can open again without spoiling the bag, perhaps use bag clamps. IF there's a lot of air in the bags, the sit on them when you bind the knot.
